FUNDING

The Commonwealth Heritage Forum will award four full bursaries to include: full course fees, including accommodation and meals; return air travel from home country to the UK; travel from UK airport to Dumfries House; and visa costs (if applicable).

ELIGIBILITY

There are no academic entry requirements for the bursaries or the Summer School. However, applicants should have prior experience in the built environment, whether academic, practically or professionally. Priority will be given to those seeking to advance their knowledge and career in the heritage sector.

We invite applications for the Hamish Ogston Foundation Commonwealth Bursaries from applicants who are citizens and/or residents of Commonwealth member states, excluding UK citizens and/or residents.

TIMELINE

We endeavour to process applications and notify applicants as soon as possible. We ask that you make sure that you can accept the bursary and attend the programme in advance of making an application (i.e. check with your employer, university, etc). We have set out the following timeline for your information:

Monday 3 April 2023 Deadline for Bursary Applications

Monday 10 April 2023 Deadline for Successful Applicants to accept bursaries

May, June & July 2023 Support in making travel and visa arrangements, if required

Saturday 8 July 2023 Bursary recipients arrive at Glasgow Airport and stay overnight in

hotel accommodations

Sunday 9 July 2023 Start of Summer School programme







Friday 28 July 2023 End of Summer School programme

Saturday 29 July 2023 Bursary recipients depart Glasgow Airport to return home

Hamish Ogston Foundation Commonwealth Bursaries Terms and Conditions

About you

- Bursary recipients must attend the full three-week course at The Prince's Foundation Summer School.
- You must not be in receipt of any other financial award for this opportunity.
- You must be working broadly in the areas of traditional building and craft skills and be seeking to advance your career in traditional building and craft skills over the subsequent years.
- You must be a citizen or resident of specified Commonwealth countries and/or territories that the Commonwealth Heritage Forum has included as eligible in this initial year of the funding.

What the Commonwealth Heritage Forum will offer

- A bursary for the full three-week course at The Prince's Foundation Summer School, lasting from 9
 July to 28 July 2023.
- Full course fees will be paid by the Commonwealth Heritage Forum directly to The Prince's Foundation according to their payment schedule.
- The cost of return air travel from your home country to the UK.
- The cost of applying for a visa, covering the duration of the course (currently £100).
- The cost of return transportation from UK airport to Dumfries House.
- Other necessary travel expenses, at the discretion of the Commonwealth Heritage Forum.
- You will be supported by the Commonwealth Heritage Forum, who will endeavour to help you develop
 a career network; encourage you to meet Commonwealth Heritage Forum members; and provide
 additional support for any issues relating to your successful progress.

What we expect from you

- To comply with all rules and regulations set out by The Prince's Foundation for admissions and participation in The Prince's Foundation Summer School.
- You may be invited to participate in live training projects with Commonwealth Heritage Forum future, including helping to lead or deliver training and seminars related to your specialism, both in your home country and other parts of the Commonwealth.
- A summary and/or evaluation of your experience at The Prince's Foundation Summer School will be requested following the course, and should be received by the Commonwealth Heritage Forum by I September 2023.
- Accounts of your experience at The Prince's Foundation Summer School, including images, and the
 progress of your future career, may be requested and featured in the Commonwealth Heritage
 Forum's publications and webpages, or those of the Hamish Ogston Foundation and The Prince's
 Foundation, or form part of a report to donors and supporters.
